News You Can Use

How does one put an economic value on the time volunteers give to an organization? Traditionally volunteer time has been estimated using a single dollar value for all types of volunteering. The *Value of Volunteer Time*, which is updated annually, is made available by Independent Sector. The dollar value of volunteer time for 2007 is estimated at \$19.51 per hour. The value of volunteer time is based on the average hourly earnings of all production and nonsupervisory workers on private nonfarm payrolls (as determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics). Independent Sector takes this figure and increases it by 12 percent to estimate for fringe benefits. pointsoflight.org and independentsector.org
